success he was legate of legio ii augusta during the roman

december 21 vespasian s position was officially confirmed by
the senate but he remained quite frank about the military

origin of his rule he dated his powers to July 1 when the troops had acclaimed him thus flouting constitutional precedent and contradicting even the behaviour of his rival Vitellius who had awaited confirmation by the senate
